THE GCP'S C2C OFF-ROAD BUSWAY

The Greater Cambridge Partnership (GCP) want to build an off-road busway from Cambourne to Cambridge (C2C) at a cost of at least £180 million.

The proposed route will cut through Green Belt land.

It will destroy Coton Orchard – the county's largest traditional orchard and a County Wildlife Site

It will irreversibly damage landscape and views.

We are wholly in favour of public transport solutions and a better C2C bus service. But the GCP's off-road scheme will not provide a solution or a good service.

There is a viable cost-effective on-road route, which:

- is much less damaging to the environment
- is far less expensive
- offers better journeys to most key destinations.
